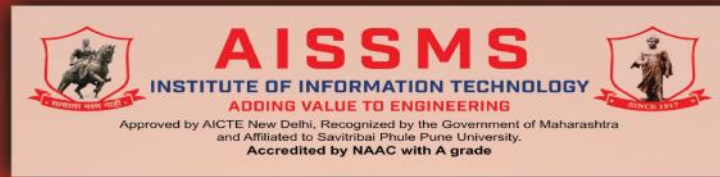

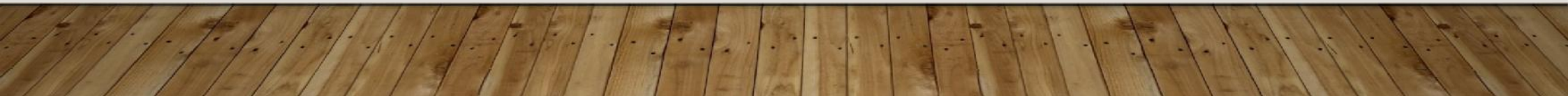

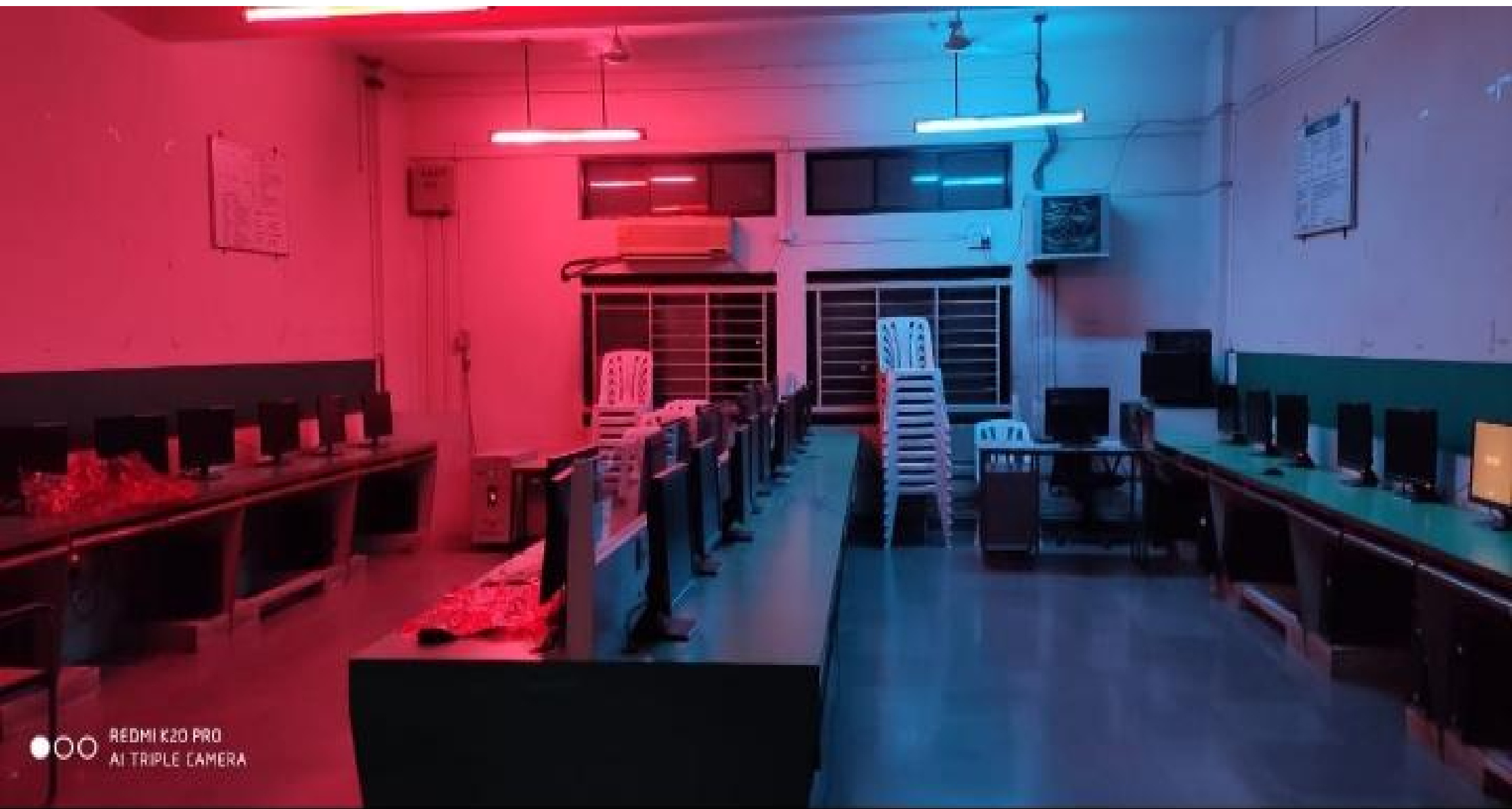

Evolution of Design



Our first design on paper resembled the standard seaperch design but we replaced the PVC with CPVC to reduce mass and drag. We had vertical bars in the front with a net extending from them and the left and right motors were attached to these bars. The net was made by bending the mesh that came in the seaperch kit and zip-tying it to the ROV. We had two shorter vertical bars with a horizontal bar connecting them on which we placed the up-down motor. In the very back we had another arch that was the same size as the arch holding the net; this was used to maintain elasticity and to have even weight distribution. In the front we had a bar going across the width to push the golf balls up the ramp in the ORBS game.



While building our design that we had sketched, we realized we needed to make some changes. First, the bar holding the up-down motor was removed and the motor was repositioned on the bar in the rear. The bar now holding the up down motor was shortened. The measurements were adjusted because, from previous experience, we knew that if the center of gravity and center of buoyancy were too close, controlling the sub would be very difficult. We added a crocheted needle to the bar in the front across the width for the rings game at our regional competition. We changed the joints in the front connecting the length and width bar from elbows to Ts. We did this so the water would flow through the seaperch, entering in the front and exiting in the rear, limiting turbulence. We added floats and a few seven gram washers to achieve neutral buoyancy.



Objective: To build a ROV with a small mass that was quick, maneuverable, and balanced while efficiently completing ORBS.



We replaced the mesh net with one woven from fishing line to reduce drag and mass. We moved the up down motor to a bar across the width without vertical dimension for better stability. Previously when we moved up or down the back would go first dragging the front behind it. After moving the up down motor to the center of the seaperch, the stability was increased and it was level while moving up and down. We also noticed that while practicing the rings game for our regional competition the rings would weigh down the seaperch. To fix this we removed the front bar and added a new bar, extending half the width, for the golf balls. We also added a 6 inch piece of CPVC extending from the center of gravity to pick up the rings and maintain stability while doing so. Behind the bar holding the up down motor we added another bar so the height was not greater than the length. We removed the 7g washers.

The net woven from fishing line was too small and tight so the balls bounced out of it. We made a new net out of bird netting and left slack in it to create a pocket to hold the balls in ORBS. We added netting between the two uprights to prevent the smallest balls from slipping out. This was the design we used at our regional competition.

Strategy

Maneuverability: The net is bent down because, otherwise, the water flowing under the net will push the seaperch upward and cause it not to drive straight underwater.

ORBS: We release all of the golf balls first because at our regional competition the tether knocked a few of the balls into the trough. We will release one of each type of whiffle ball and pick them all up at once and put them in the bucket. We will pick the softball up first because it is the largest and most likely to slip out of the net. Once all the whiffle balls and under the bucket we will push the golf balls up the ramp.



We switched to larger propellers ones to increase propulsion. We removed the 6 inch bar in the front that we used for the rings game because it is unnecessary. We also removed the bar that extended half of the width for the golf balls. On the joints that previously held these two extensions we put two one inch pieces of CPVC. We added a hook on the bar in the rear to pick up the golf balls. The hook was made out of two semicircles of wire about an inch and a half apart; this acted as a basket to drag the golf balls up the ramp. We added more slack to the net so we could comfortably fit more balls at once. We replaced the floats with fresh ones to obtain optimal buoyancy. We wove a thread through the portion of the net near the up-down motor to pull it tight so the up-down propeller would not hit the net.

Explanation of Final Design

This design is able to perform in ORBS and the maneuverability challenge successfully. The thin netting allows for slack to be left in the net without creating drag while enabling us to pick up multiple whiffle balls and once. The wire frame is strong and flexible helping to release balls and is adjusted for the maneuverability game. The basket on the rear is effectively able to move the golf balls up the ramp. The craft is very stable because we located the centers of gravity and buoyancy on the same plane but they were distanced enough to be distinguishable. We decreased turbulence by leaving the ends of the CPVC open so water would enter the front and leave through the back. The increased propulsion with larger propellers allows the ROV to travel faster assisting in maneuvering. With all accessories, the sub measures 14.5" in length, 7" in height, 8" in width, and 538 grams.

Conclusion

Building a ROV that is small, fast, and maneuverable and that had an effective net to capture the balls in the ORBS game was challenging but very educational. Though it took a lot of trial and error and generating of innovative designs to reach this point, our final design meets each aspect of our objective. We learned to be patient and change one element at a time rather than trying all proposed solutions to a problem at once. Though each of us took away different lessons from this experience, we all learned more about the importance of communication between team members and applying scientific principles to our design.

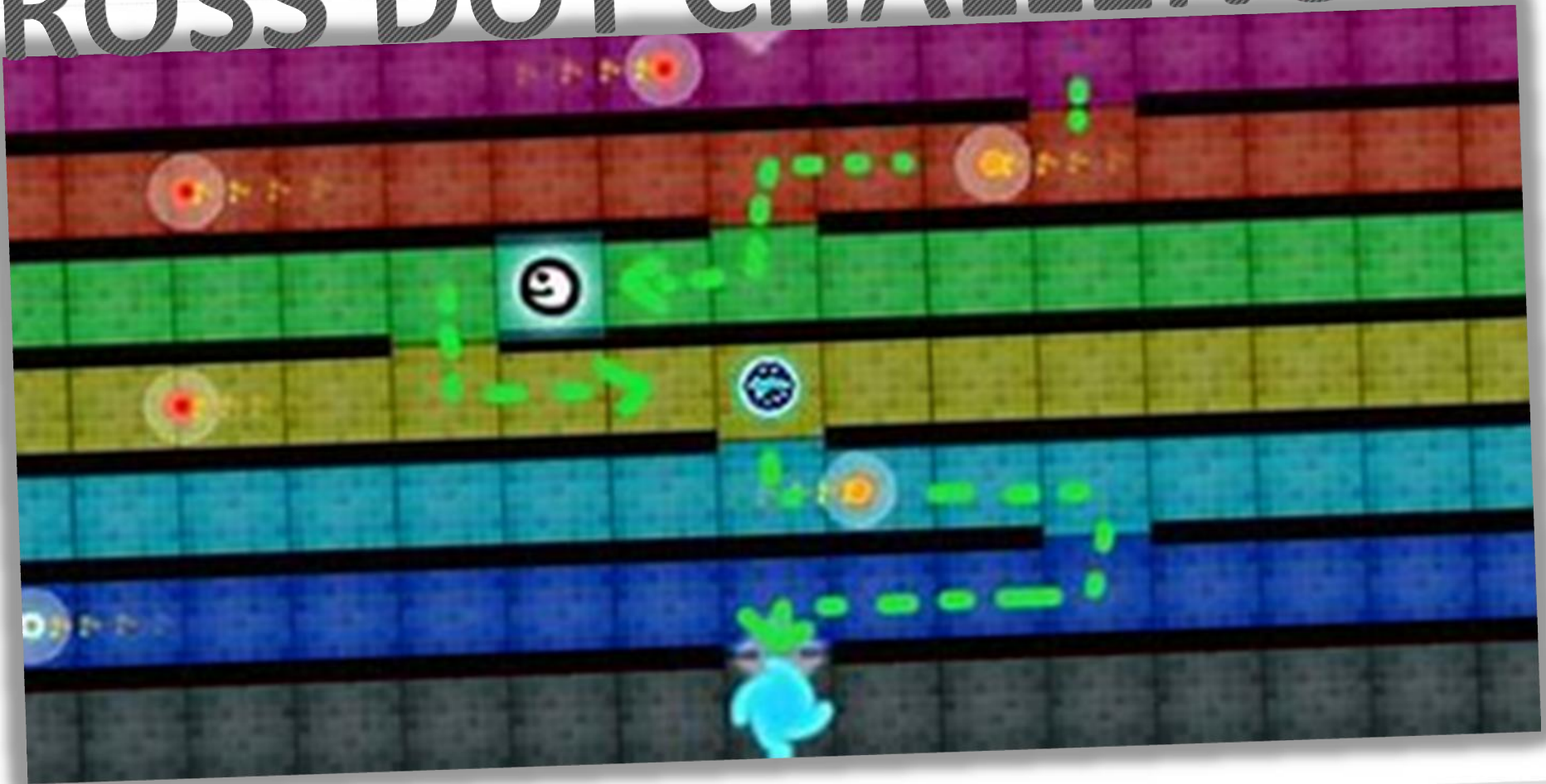
