International Yoga Day Report

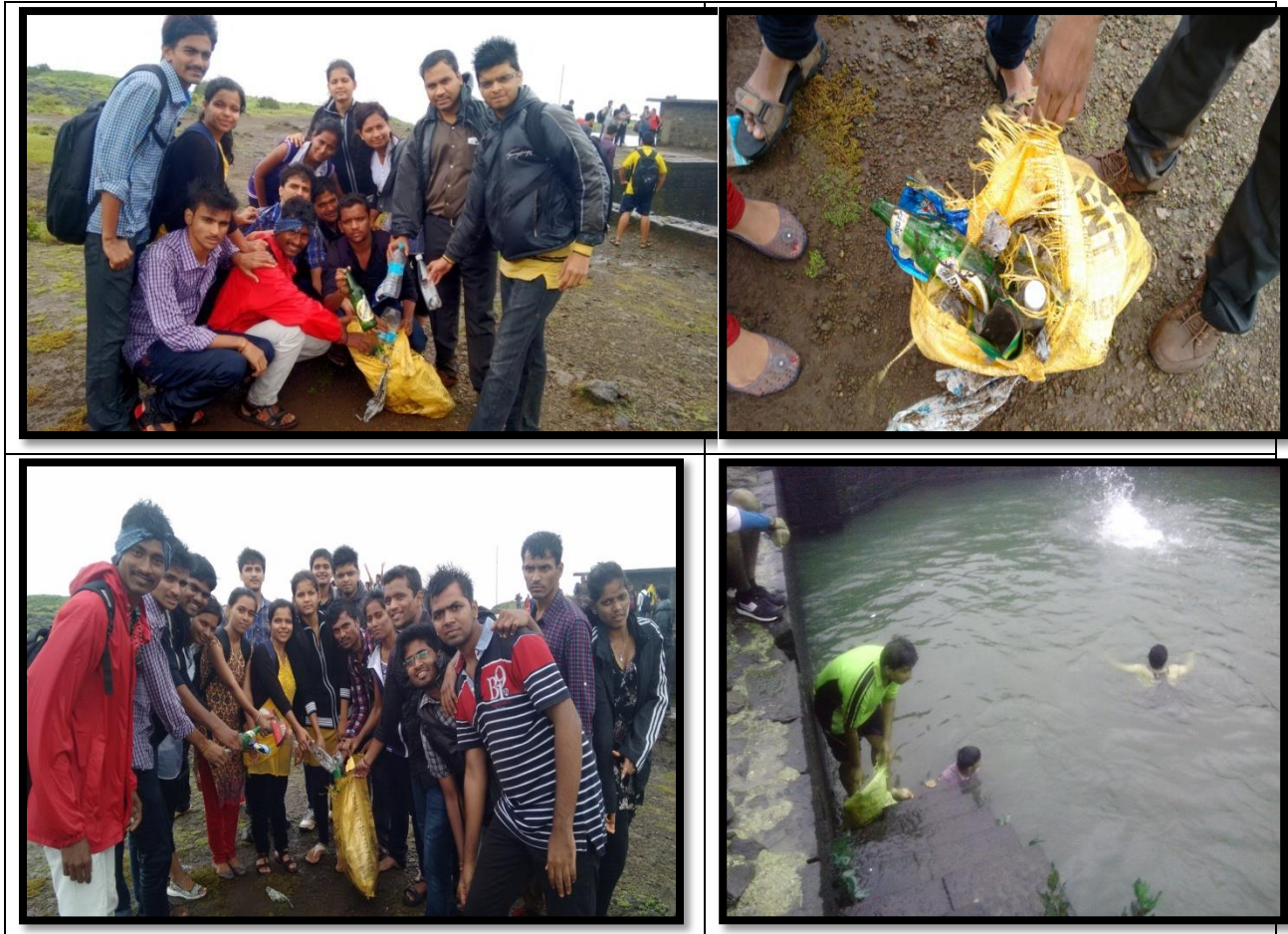
Date: 21/06/2015

Street play report

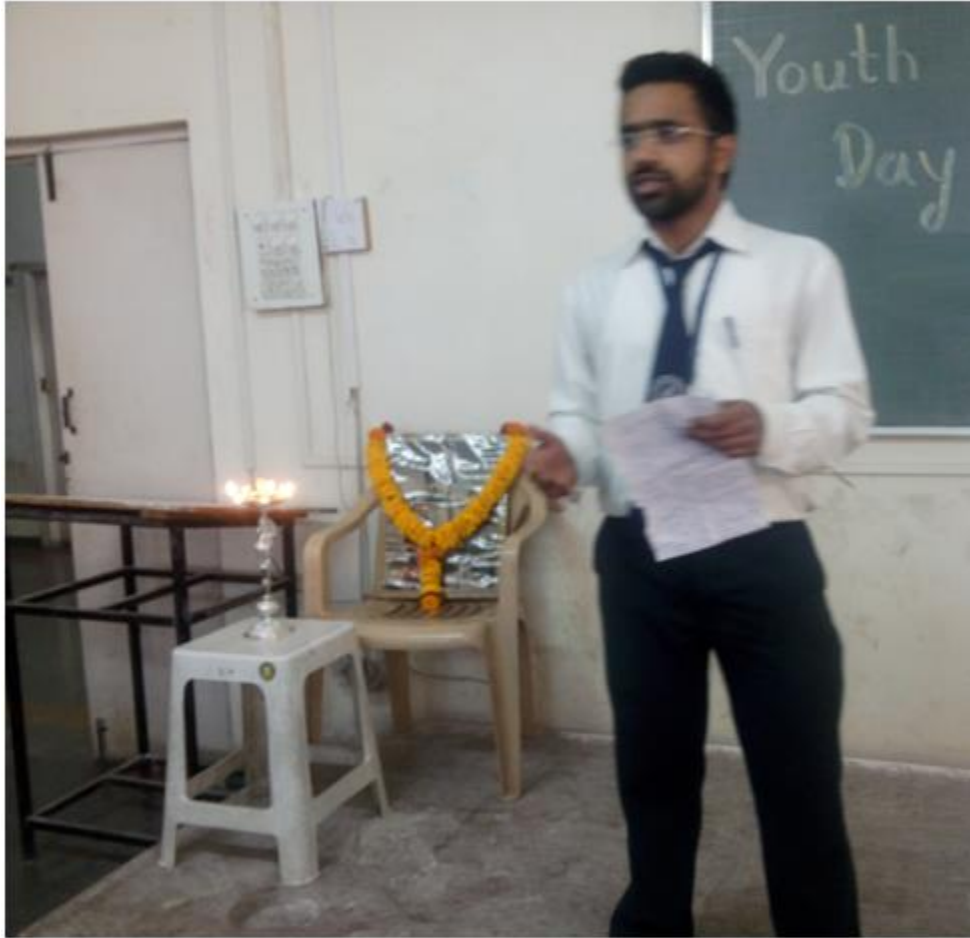
Date:05/01/2016
