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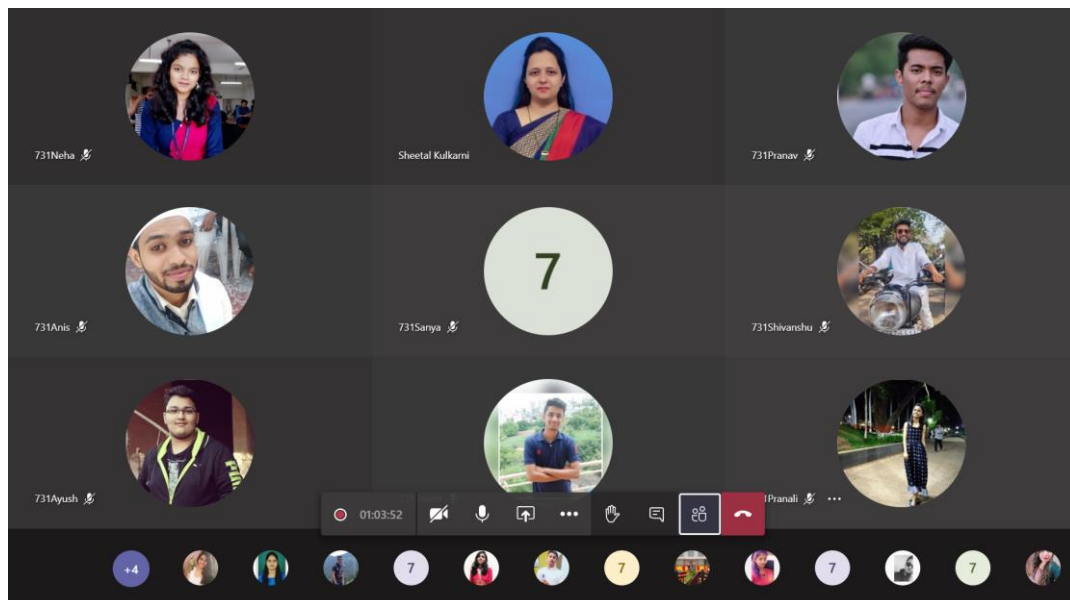
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SADBHAVANA DAY 20/08/2020

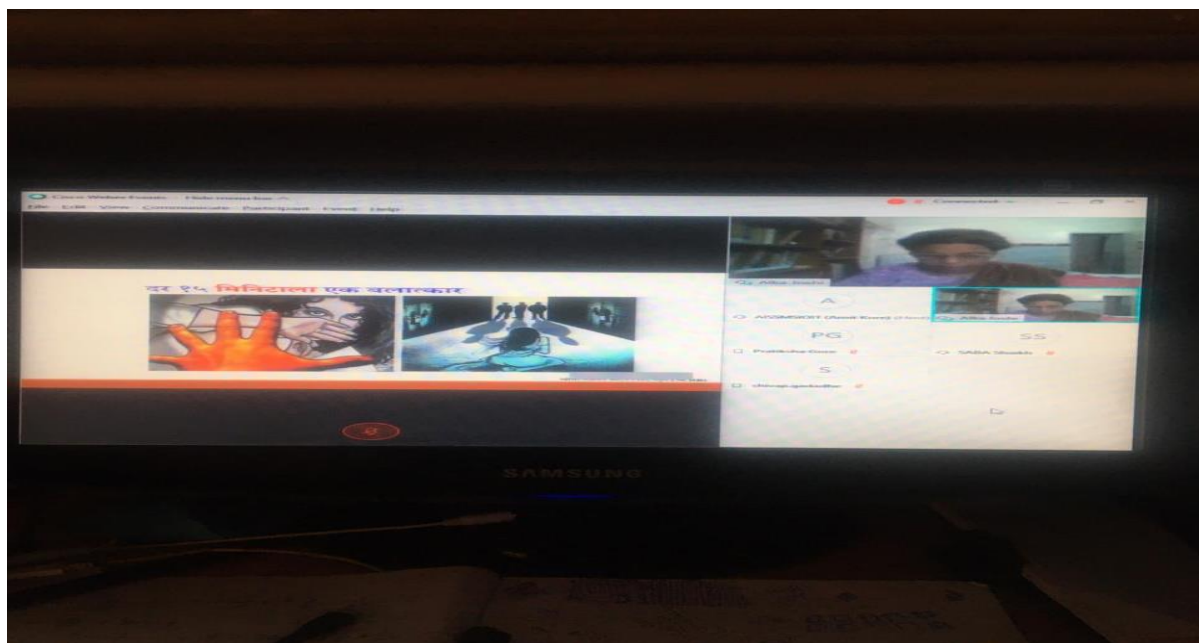


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GENDER EQUALITY WEBINAR 06/07/2020

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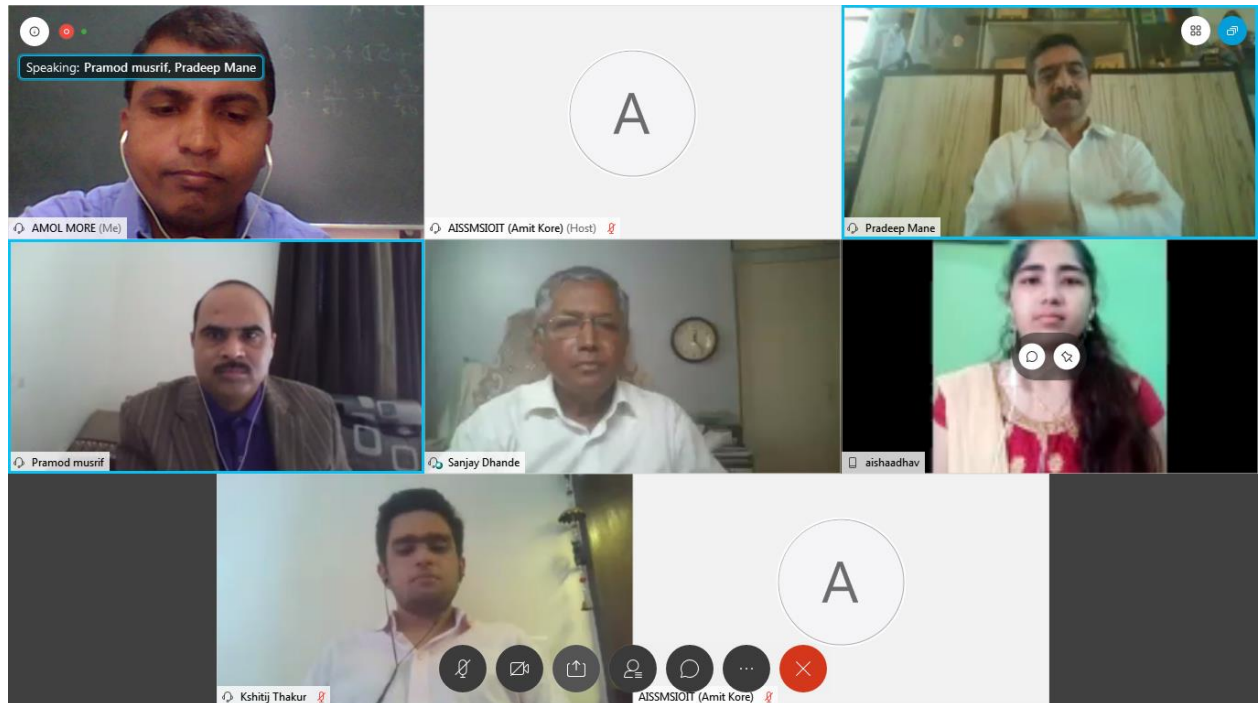
TEACHERS DAY 04/09/2020

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


“AZADI KA AMRUTMAHOSTAV”: 25/03/2021
