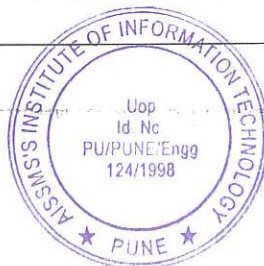

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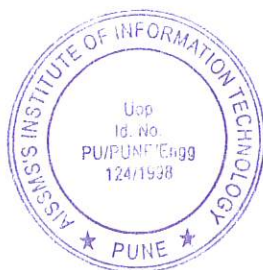

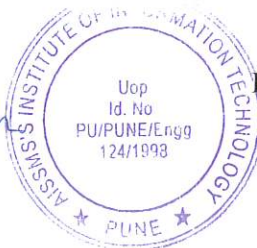

To spread awareness about voluntary blood donation and encourage a culture of life-saving contributions.

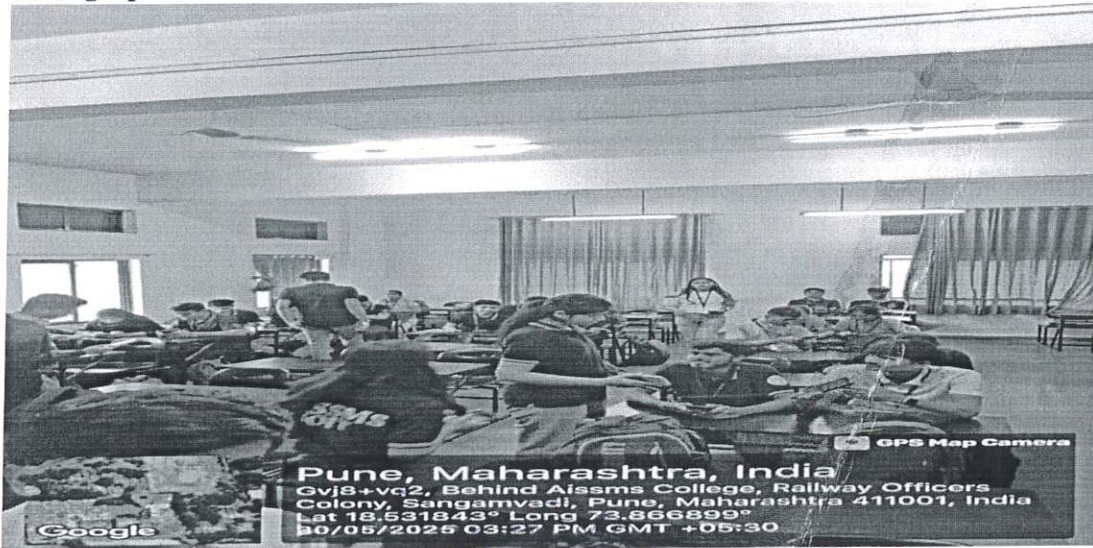
Details:

To spread awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco and promote a healthy lifestyle.

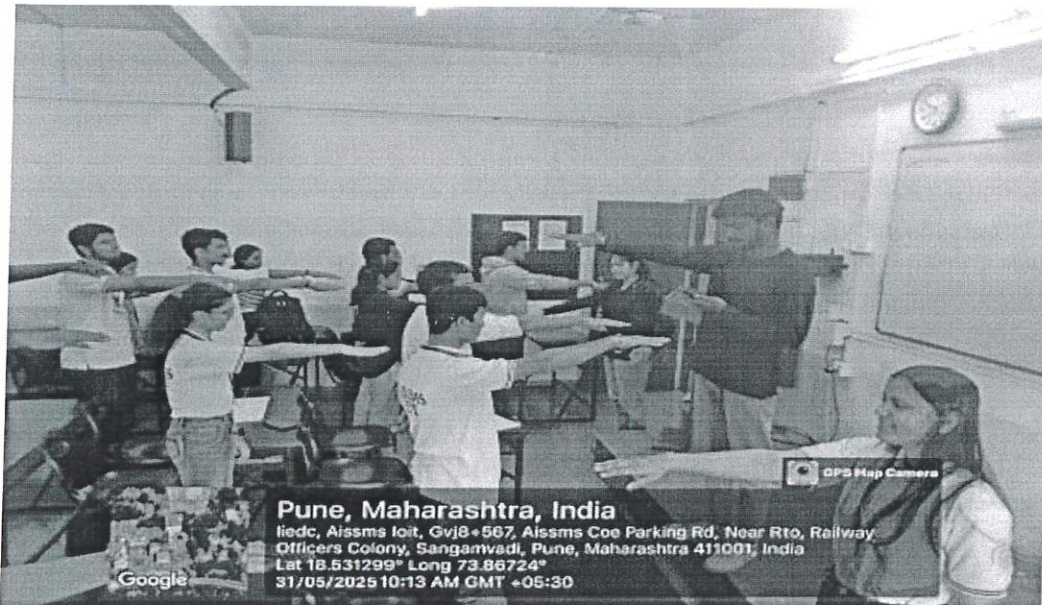
Activity Details:

To educate students about food safety standards and promote hygienic practices.

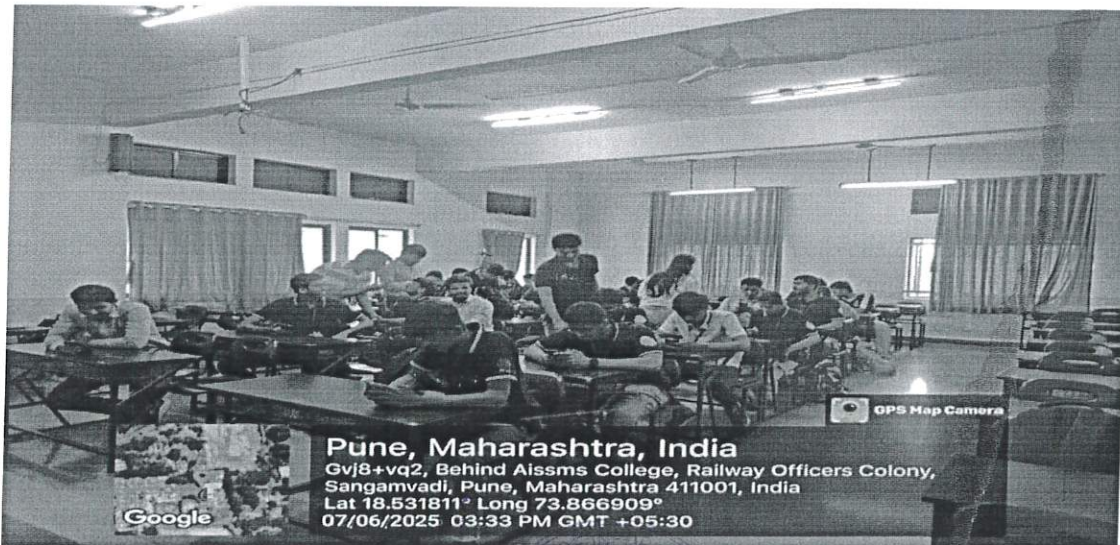
Details:

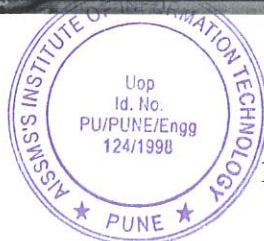

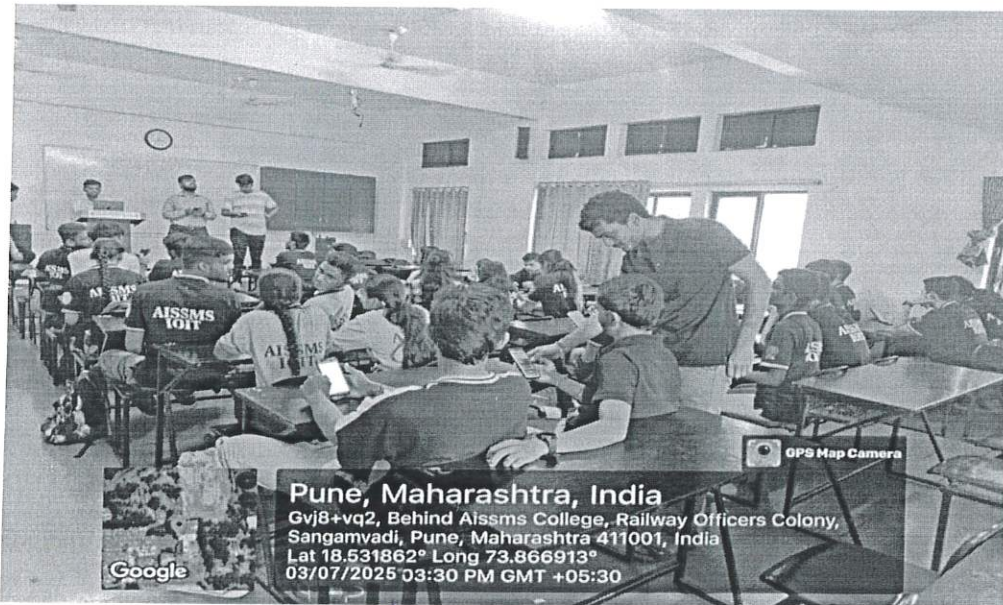
Objective: To enhance student awareness about the impact of plastic and promote sustainable alternatives.

Activity Details:

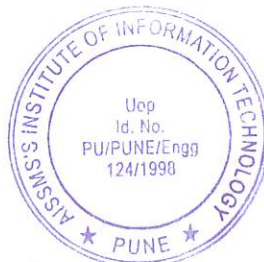

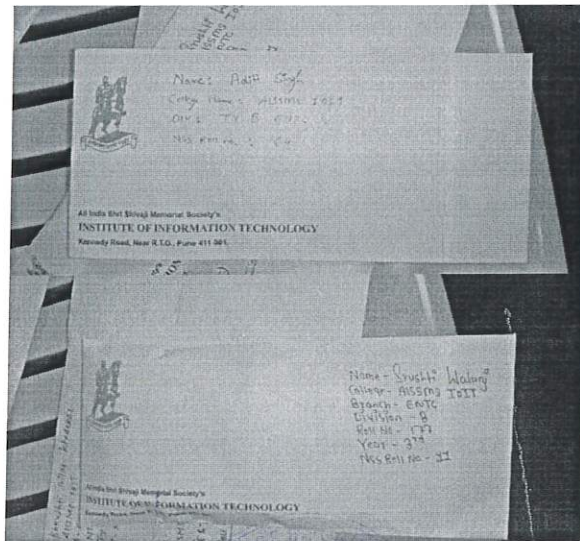
Details:

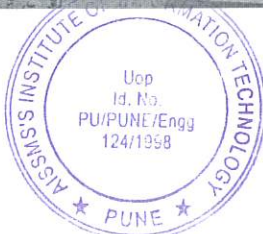
Outcome:

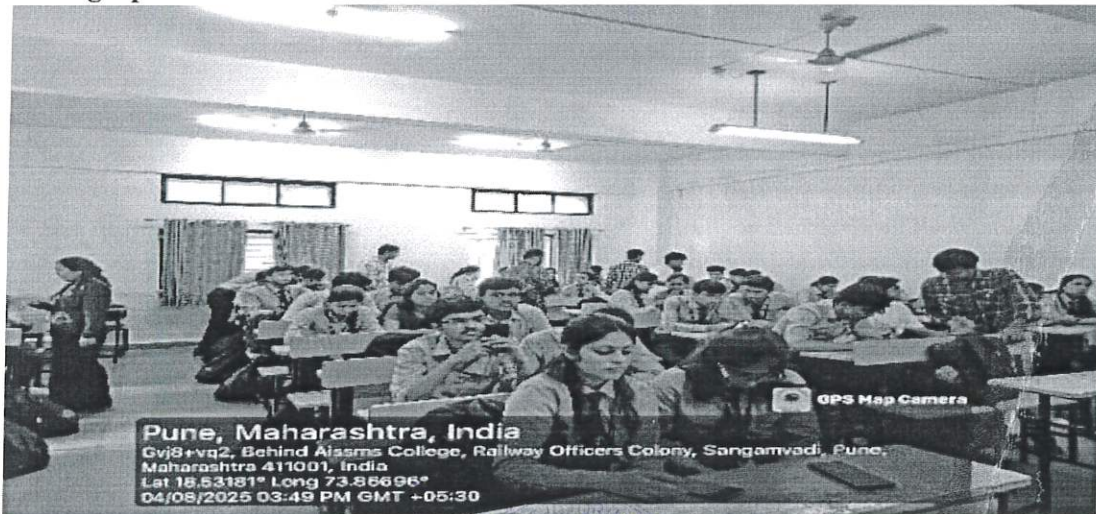
Activity Details:

The entire program was conducted smoothly with enthusiastic participation from students and staff, making the celebration impactful and inspiring.

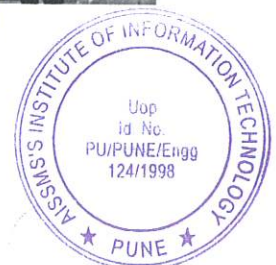
