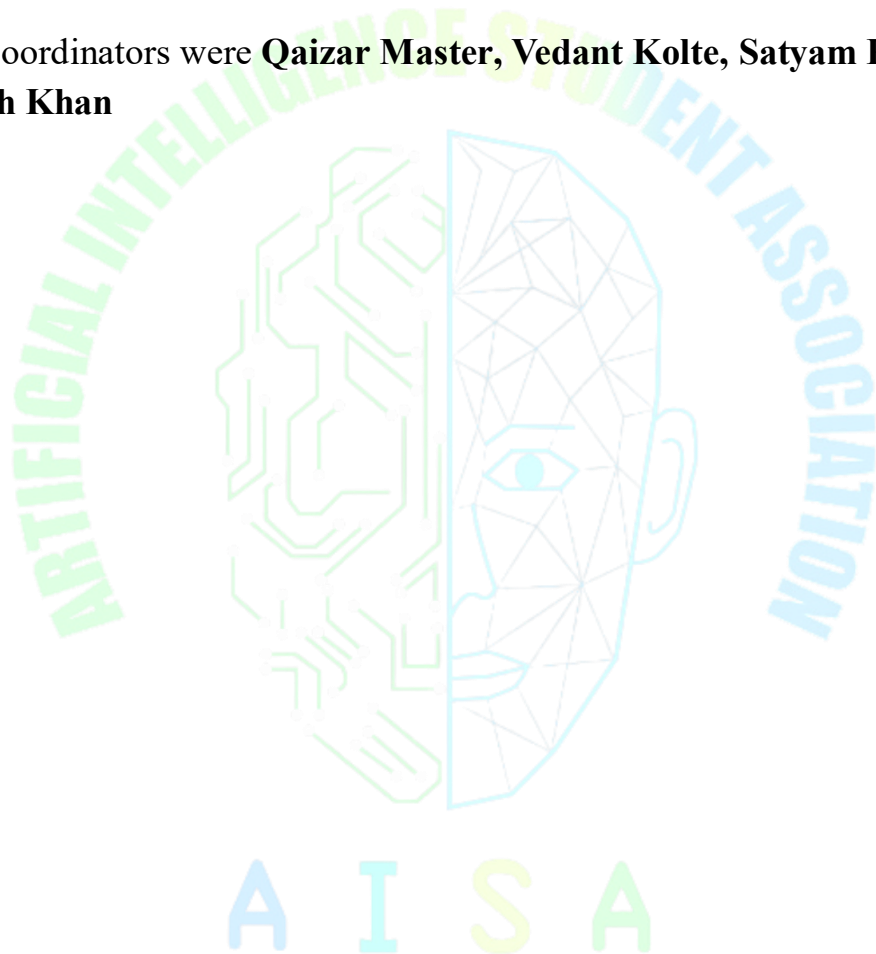

The primary aim of the event was to introduce participants to the concept of **AI-driven user interface creation** and to enhance their **prompt engineering and design interpretation skills**. In this challenge, participants were provided with a **sample reference UI or webpage layout**, which served as the benchmark for the task. The participants were required to analyze the given design and **recreate a similar UI using various AI tools by crafting effective and precise prompts**.

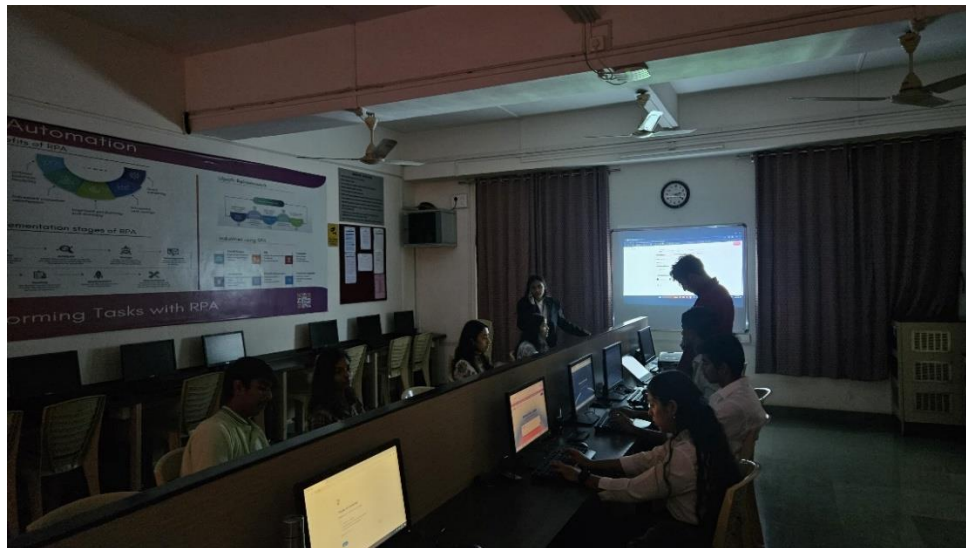

Participants experimented with different AI-based UI generation tools, gaining hands-on exposure to how varying prompts can produce diverse design outcomes. Through this activity, students became familiar with **multiple AI UI tools**, improved their understanding of **UI/UX** concepts, and learned how AI can assist in frontend design and rapid prototyping. 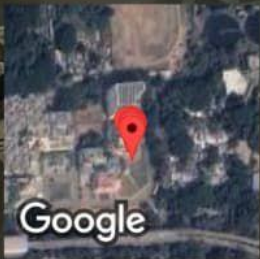

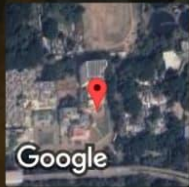
